KIDS PATH AWARDED GRANT FOR EXPANSION OF CHAMP CAMP

(GREENSBORO, NORTH CAROLINA)—Thanks to the Future Fund of the Community Foundation of Greater Greensboro, Hospice and Palliative Care of Greensboro (HPCG) has been awarded a grant in the amount of \$4,900 to increase the participation and expansion of Kids Path’s CHAMP Camp.

CHAMP Camp, held annually in the spring, takes place at Haw River State Park in Brown Summit, North Carolina for bereaved children and teens. The camp allows grieving children and teens a chance to share memories, and hosts various activities for the participants to process their emotions.

The grant will allow Kids Path to provide enough resources to allow more participants for the 2014 spring CHAMP Camp. This year, the event had more than 50 campers; each was grieving the death of a loved one.

“CHAMP Camp provides a fun and supportive environment for children to connect with others their age who are coping with similar life circumstances,” said Kath Hubbard, Kids Path social worker and program coordinator.

HPCG, a nonprofit organization serving Guilford County and surrounding areas for more than 30 years, is situated on an eight-acre campus at 2500 Summit Avenue. HPCG provides physical, emotional and spiritual support for children and adults faced with a life-limiting illness, as well as their caregivers and families.
