Purpose

Kids Path, a distinctive children's program of Hospice and Palliative Care of Greensboro (HPCG), offers supportive services to parents who are expecting a baby with a life-threatening condition.

We Serve Expectant Parents...

- Who have an unborn baby with a diagnosis of a life-threatening condition.
- Who desire comfort care for their baby.
- Who are under the care of a physician. Perinatal hospice care is comfort and support. The program does not provide medical or skilled nursing care.
- Who live in the Greater Greensboro area.

Services Provided

- Assistance with addressing goals during pregnancy, delivery and the time following the baby's birth.
- Supportive counseling for parents and siblings.
- Access to resources and referrals as needed.
- Assistance with the creation of memories and keepsakes.
- Plan of care for the baby at home if desired.
